


A Police Officer's Heart

50 X50 Quilt Pattern



Instructions: You can use any shade of blue and/or patriotic fabrics. Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam. To make the quilt, sew each row first and then sew rows together.

Fabrics Yardage:

4 shades of blue: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of each color

1 White: 1 yard

Borders: 1 Yard

Fabric Cuts Check-off List

- 2 White $12\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ Squares
- 4 White 13×13 Squares to cut into **8** Half Square Triangles
- 6 Blue $12\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ Squares
- 4 Blue 13×13 Squares to cut into **8** Half Square Triangles


Cutting half square triangles: Take each 13×13 square and cut diagonally from the top left corner to the bottom right corner.

SEE DIAGRAM on Page 3, TO SEW QUILT BLOCKS


Borders: After the entire quilt-top is sewn, add a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch border around the entire quilt.


